DECLARING LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AND RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY OF SECURITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the University of the Philippines Mindanao, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), posted on the PhilGEPS website, on the UP Mindanao website, and in a conspicuous place within the campus for at least seven (7) calendar days the Invitation to Bid for the Supply of Security Services with the following approved budget for each lot, namely:

WHEREAS, as a result of the website postings two bidders purchased bid documents and submitted their bids for Lot 1 and Lot 2 upon the deadline for submission on March 2, 2021

WHEREAS, upon opening and preliminary examination of the bid documents submitted by the two bidders, both of them were declared eligible for bidding;

WHEREAS, upon opening of the financial envelopes submitted, the following were the bids as read, namely:
