#### Description

#### INVITATION TO BID FOR THE SUPPLY OF LABORATORY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PHILIPPINE GENOME CENTER (PGC) MINDANAO

The University of the Philippines Mindanao, through the GAA 2019 intends to apply the sum of Thirteen Million Seven Hundred Ninety Thousand Pesos Only [P13,790,000.00] being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the SUPPLY OF LABORATORY EQUIPMENT FOR PHILIPPINE GENOME CENTER (PGC) MINDANAO consisting of two (2) lots. Bids received in excess of the ABC of each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The University of the Philippines now invites bids for the Supply of Laboratory Equipment for the Philippine Genome Center (PGC) Mindanao consisting of two (2) lots. Delivery of the Goods is required 90 days for Lot 1, and 60-90 days for Lot 2, reckoned from receipt of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent
