BAC Resolution No. 25 s. of 2023

DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDS (LCRB) AND RECOMMENDING AWARD OF THE CONTRACTS FOR LOTS 1 – 4 OF THE SUPPLY OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE INFECTIOUS DISEASES LABORATORY (PBM 2023-17)

WHEREAS, the University of the Philippines Mindanao, through its Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (BAC), posted on the PhilGEPS website, on the UP Mindanao website, and in a conspicuous place within the campus for at least seven (7) calendar days, the Invitation to Bid of the Supply of Equipment for the Infectious Diseases Laboratory (PBM 2023-17) consisting of four (4) lots with total approved budget for the contract (ABC) in the amount of P8,700,000.00;

WHEREAS, as a result of such postings three (3) bidders purchased bid documents and submitted their bids upon the deadline for submission on June 27, 2023; After the preliminary checking all the three bidders were declared eligible for bidding;

WHEREAS, upon opening and checking of the financial bids, the BAC read out the following bid amounts, namely:

WHEREAS, for Lot 1 – Cold Storage, after the Technical Working Group (TWG) and end-user unit's representative conducted a thorough evaluation and post qualification of the bid documents submitted by Levin's International Corporation, the lowest calculated bid (LCB), the said bidder was found to be non-compliant and non-responsive to the technical specifications; whereas upon post qualification of the 2nd lowest calculated bid, RainPhil Inc. its bid was found to be compliant and responsive to the technical specifications;

WHEREAS, for Lot 2 – Centrifuge, the TWG reported that the bid submitted by RainPhil Inc., the lowest calculated for this lot, was found to be compliant and responsive to the requirements;

WHEREAS, for Lot 3 – Biocontainment, Sterilization and Small Equipment, the Technical Working Group and the end-user unit's representative found the bid of Biosite Medical Instruments, the lowest calculated bid, to be non-compliant to the specifications. The TWG and end-user then conducted the evaluation and post qualification on the bid of the other bidder, Levin's International Corporation which was found to be compliant and responsive to the technical requirements;

WHEREAS, for Lot 4 – Liquid Handling System, after the Technical Working Group and the end-user unit's representative conducted a thorough evaluation and post qualification of the bid documents submitted by the LCB Levin's International Corporation, it was found to be non-compliant to the specifications, while the next lowest bidder, RainPhil Inc. was able to comply with the technical requirements for this lot;

NOW THEREFORE, we the members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

1) To declare the following bidders as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bids for the lots indicated below:
